July 18 - July 23, 2016 Camp Woodland Hills Regulations

The following regulations apply to each Band Camp Participant

- The river and trails outside the Camp Woodland Hills area are restricted. No band member should enter these areas at any time.
- Any departure from Camp Woodland Hills must be granted, as well as documented by both your Cabin Counselor and the Camp Coordinator. A signature of departure, as well as a signature of return must be obtained.
- All Band members must be in their assigned lodge room or cabin by 11:00pm each evening.
- Lights out and silence is required in all band member lodge rooms and cabins by 12:00am.
- No band member may leave their assigned lodge room or cabin after 11:00pm without the permission of their Cabin Counselor or the Camp Coordinator.
- All Camp area will be kept cleaned and organized. Both the lodge rooms and each cabin will be provided cleaning supplies and usage instructions. Each room or cabin will be inspected daily. The Camp Coordinator will complete a FINAL INSPECTION on the morning of departure from camp.
- Swimming is allowed only during designated times and with a Camp provided Lifeguard present.
- Each band member is expected to exhibit respect for fellow band members, Cabin Counselors, Adult Camp Assistants, Woodland Hills Camp Staff, and all visiting guests, as well as all camp property.
- No profanity will be tolerated while on Camp Woodland Hills property.
- No conflicts or fighting (verbal/physical) will be tolerated when on Camp Woodland Hills property.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited when on Camp Woodland Hills property.
- Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited when on Camp Woodland Hills property.
- Illegal drugs are strictly prohibited when on Camp Woodland Hills property.

Failure to comply with the above or additional regulations that may be communicated throughout the course of Band Camp may result in a dismissal from Camp Woodland Hills and/or the SCW Marching Warrior Band Program.
